**06.12.2025: Inauguration of the Camp**

The Annual NSS Camp (2025-2026) was held at T.K. Puram Village from 6.12.2025 to 12.12.2025. Dr. (Sr) Mary Josphine Rani wished the NSS Volunteers and the Programme Officers and the camp was inaugurated by Dr. (Sr) Arokia Jayaceli A Principal. The inaugural session was further enriched by an inspiring motivational address delivered by Lion T.
