The college founded in the year 1954 by a great visionary Rev. Sr. Cesira Galena, consistently caters to the needs of young women, with an emphasis on holistic formation, updated syllabi and value based education to enable the students to face the future with courage and confidence. Reaching out to the current pandemic situation, the Management had arranged online classes on a regular basis to UG and PG of all programmes. The college has also attempted a debut venture into adopting the Outcome Based Education Syllabus to the first year students of both UG and PG courses, for this academic year 2020-21.

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

A Soft Skills Training Programme for all II and III year UG students of Shifts I & II was offered through SMART Organisation to equip them to cater to the requisites of employment opportunities.

Mr. Kulandei Francis, RAMON MAGSASAY Award Winner, President of IVDP extends regular support for the educational needs of the students of Auxilium. An amount of Rs. 8,87,500/- was extended this academic year to 114 single-parent and orphan students. 86 management staff were offered Tablet Computers to enable online instruction to students with a generous contribution of Rs.9 Lakhs from Mr. Kulandei Francis.

Sports
