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GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT FOR THE YEAR 2024-25

CURRICULUM

- New programmes (B.Sc. Data Science and Ph.D. Biochemistry) were introduced
- TANSCHÉ syllabus was implemented for all programmes with a required modification by the Board of Studies of the departments.
- MOOC courses were added as an integral component in the programme structure of I year Postgraduate students as a mandatory component (as per TANSCHÉ Regulations), the score of the same was added to their marks statement, with 2 credits weightage.
- Undergraduate programmes BBA, BBA (Hospital Administration), and BCA were approved by the AICTE.
- The Department of English prepared an exclusive General English Textbook (*Ablaze*) with comprehension and grammar exercises tailored to the learning outcomes of the course to improve the learners' communication skills.
- The Department of Tamil prepared an exclusive textbook on General Tamil for Semesters I and II for General Tamil Part I.
- Dr. Sr. Sagayamary T., Head, Department of Commerce, and Mrs. Sasikala, Assistant Professor of Commerce, authored the textbook on Company Law for B.Com. students
- Dr. Kavitha S., Assistant Professor of Computer Science, authored a textbook titled Foundations of Data Science.

TEACHING, LEARNING AND EVALUATION

- Digital Learning Day was observed on the first Monday every month. The Course instructors involved students in digital learning for their respective courses.

- Enterprise Resource Planning ERP was enhanced with special features for lesson plan and the activities of Faculty Members.
- Online Evaluation was implemented for 30% of answer scripts from November 2025
- The Students of MBA enrolled from the academic year 2025-26 will have practical, activity-based Assessment for II Continuous Assessment.

RESEARCH INNOVATION AND EXTENSION

- 4 Faculty Members were approved as Research Supervisors by the Thiruvalluvar University
- 10 Ph.D. scholars were awarded doctoral degrees
- 12 MoUs were signed
- 8 Patents and 1 copyright were obtained by Faculty Members
- 141 Papers were published by Faculty Members
- An action-research project was undertaken by the college in collaboration with the Central Institute of Leather, Govt. of India.
- Students' Carnival AUXIS' 25 was organized by the Student's Union with a variety of recreational programmes for students, and commercial stalls. The fund raised from the event was donated for the welfare of the aged, differently-abled and the transgender society.
- The college undertook a massive drive - Mega seed-ball Fiesta for the preparation of seed balls. The students came together to make 5 lakhs seedballs, which was dispersed in the neighbouring hills and plains, to promote green Vellore.
- The faculty and students of Computer Applications worked on a project to make the botanical diversity of the campus accessible through digital technology. The common name and biological name, benefits of the names of each tree was encoded in a QR code, and it was displayed on all the trees in the college

INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

- Construction of additional classrooms in the computer block has been initiated
- 5 Smartboards were installed
- 10 surveillance cameras were installed

STUDENT SUPPORT AND PROGRESSION

- Exclusive programmes for differently-abled students were organized.
- Orientation and Counselling on placement and career choices were conducted throughout the academic year. An on-campus placement drive was organised, About 38 reputed companies and institutions conducted interviews and 506 students were placed in various companies across the country.
- Summer Skill-up Programme was organized to teach new skills to students during the summer holidays.
- Programmes on Cybersecurity was conducted by the Cybersecurity Cell to sensitize students on Digital Wellness, responsible digital usage and mental well-being in the digital age.
- Community Outreach Programmes were aligned with Sustainable Development Goals.
- Students were supported with several Merit-based and Need-based scholarships
