Introduction

World Day Against Trafficking in Persons is observed every year on 30 July to raise awareness about the global issue of human trafficking and to advocate for the protection of victims' rights. Human trafficking is one of the most serious violations of human rights, involving the exploitation of individuals through force, coercion, deception, or abuse of vulnerability. Victims may be trafficked for forced labour, sexual exploitation, domestic servitude, forced marriage, child labour, organ removal, or other forms of exploitation. The observance of this day aims to educate communities about the realities of trafficking, encourage vigilance, strengthen preventive measures, and promote coordinated action among governments, law enforcement agencies, non-governmental organizations, educational institutions, and the public. As future social workers, students have an important role in promoting awareness, supporting survivors, and advocating for social justice and human rights. So, to bring an awareness about the Human Trafficking day the PG department of Social Work conducted Quiz and Reel Competition on July 30 in Auxilium College, Vellore for both UG & PG students.

Objectives

1. To create awareness about the causes, forms, and consequences of human trafficking.
2. To educate participants on identifying the warning signs of trafficking.
3. To familiarize students with national and international efforts to combat trafficking.
4. To emphasize the rights, protection, and rehabilitation of survivors.
5. To encourage youth participation in preventing human trafficking through community awareness and responsible citizenship.

Quiz Competition:

Commenced in Online mode through a website called [quizz.com](https://www.quizz.com) In which the Questions highlighted the significance of World Day Against Trafficking in Persons and the need for collective action against exploitation. 24 Students participated in the Quiz Competition combining both Shift I & II. The Link was shared in the Official Whatsapp Group with members of Organising Faculties and Participants of different departments. The students joined through the link which directed them to the quizz.com website. The Quiz was set for 15 mins that is from 6.15 pm to 6.30 pm. The quizz.com had the specification of Anti – Cheating Tool which was easy for the organising faculty to identify any malpractise and eliminate the participant from the competition. Participants answered the questions which was monitored by the organising faculty. Finally the quizz.com manually closed the link after the time was up.

Reels Competition:

The Theme of the Reels Competition was ‘Every Person deserves Freedom’. The Students took initiative and shot reels with the theme mentioned. The Clipping was submitted by the participants through Google Forms with the time limit of 1minute.

Conclusion

The observance of World Day Against Trafficking in Persons successfully enhanced awareness among participants regarding one of the world’s most pressing human rights issues. The programme emphasized that combating trafficking requires coordinated efforts from governments, law enforcement agencies, educational institutions, civil society organizations, and citizens. It reinforced the importance of compassion, vigilance, and social responsibility in preventing exploitation and supporting survivors. The programme inspired participants to become advocates for human rights and contribute towards building a society free from trafficking.
