The Auxilium College Library and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized a workshop titled “**Write with Integrity: Understanding and Avoiding Plagiarism**” on **28 August 2026**, from **10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.** at the **Auxilium College Auditorium**.

**Dr. K. Ramasamy, College Librarian, M.V. Muthiah Government Arts College for Women, Dindigul**, who served as the Resource Person. The programme aimed to create awareness about **academic integrity, ethical writing, plagiarism, proper citation and referencing, and responsible use of information resources**.

During the session, participants learned about different forms of plagiarism, including **direct, paraphrasing, mosaic, self and accidental plagiarism**. The resource person also explained effective paraphrasing, summarizing, citation and referencing, responsible use of digital resources, and plagiarism detection and prevention.

The workshop provided an interactive learning opportunity, enabling participants to clarify their doubts and understand how to apply ethical writing practices in their academic and research work.

The programme concluded successfully with a renewed commitment among participants to uphold **honesty, originality, responsibility and respect for intellectual contributions** in academic and research activities.
