1.A State Level Online Quiz Competition(12.08.2025)

The Red Ribbon Club of Auxilium College (Autonomous) conducted a **State-Level Online Quiz Competition** for the volunteers on 12 August 2025. The topics included HIV/STI awareness, Tuberculosis, Blood Donation, Adolescent and Public Health, and General Knowledge. 3.Blood Donation Camp-(20.08.2025)
